



## Delia M. Charest

June 11, 1914 - March 30, 2012

LANCASTER, NH— Mrs. Delia M. Charest, 97, formerly of Canaan, Vt., passed away on Friday, March 30, 2012, at the Country Village Healthcare Center in Lancaster, NH, with her two loving daughters at her side.

She was born in Norton, Vt., on June 11, 1914, a daughter to the late Leon and Lumina (Demers) Vincent. She attended the local schools in Norton as a child.

Delia was happiest when caring for her family, and was a devoted, caring mother for many years. She was active in gardening and farming with her husband, Freeman. In her later years she worked as a licensed nurse's assistant at the Coos County Nursing Hospital.
