



## Donald D. Mitchell

April 30, 1932 - November 19, 2008

PITTSBURG, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Mr. Donald D. Mitchell, 76, of Pittsburg, New Hampshire, passed away suddenly on Wednesday afternoon, November 19, 2008, off of Hill Road in Pittsburg.

Mr. Mitchell was born April 30, 1932, in Peabody, MA, the son of the late Donald D. and Cornelia (Ahearne) Mitchell, Sr.

At an early age, Mr. Mitchell's family moved from Peabody to Marblehead, MA, where he graduated from Marblehead High School and later graduated from Wentworth Institute as an architectural contractor. He enlisted in the United States Navy and served honorably during the Korean War in the Seabees. He married Joanne Krupski in 1957 and they raised their family in Wolfeboro, NH, where he owned and operated his own construction business. In 1990, he moved with his wife to Pittsburg and became an active member in the Aurora Grange #235 where he recently served as the Grange Master. His other interests included hunting, fishing, reading, gardening, and wood working. He enjoyed spending time with his family and especially loved traveling to his grandchildren's sporting events. He will be remembered as a "man's man" who was deeply committed to his family and to his trade.

Mr. Mitchell is survived by his loving wife of 51 years, Joanne Mitchell of Pittsburg, NH; his son, Stephen D. Mitchell of New Hampton, NH; his

daughter, Jennifer Tuthill and husband, William, of Somersworth, NH; his sister, Cornelia Payne of Salem, MA; five grandchildren, Derek W. Mitchell, Jesse S. Mitchell, Aaron D. Katz, Michelle B. Katz and Brooke E. Tuthill; and one nephew, John Payne of Marblehead, MA.

At Mr. Mitchell's request, there will be no calling hours. A private family graveside service will be held in the spring at the Pittsburg Hollow Cemetery.
