STEWARTSTOWN, NH—Mr. Donald R. Coleman, 78, of Stewartstown Hollow, passed away unexpectedly at his home late Friday evening, March 29, 2013.

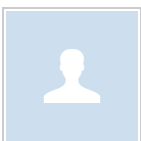
