



## Donald T. Kendall

February 13, 1954 - May 14, 2010

COLEBROOK, NH – Mr. Donald Todd Kendall, 56, of Colebrook, NH, and formerly of Medfield, Mass., died in an explosion at the MDM Muzzleloaders-Black Mag manufacturing facility in Colebrook, NH, on Friday afternoon, May 14, 2010.

He was born February 13, 1954, in Summit, New Jersey, the son of Clifford and Ruth (Parsons) Kendall. He was a graduate of Dover-Sherborn High School in Massachusetts.

Donald is survived by his mother, Ruth P. Kendall of Glen Allen, Va.; his brother and sister-in-law, James and Luba Kendall, of Valley City, Ohio; and sisters Sherry Kendall of Glen Allen, Va., and Patricia Weber of Colorado Springs, Colo.; as well as nieces and nephews.

He is preceded in death by his father, Clifford Kendall in 1994.

Donald's wishes were to be cremated and be laid to rest in the Glenwood Cemetery in Troy, Penn., with his father and other family members. A memorial celebration of his life will be held at a later date.
