WEST STEWARTSTOWN — Mrs. Doris M. DeLong, 82, of West Stewartstown, passed away at the Coös County Nursing Hospital on Sunday evening, Aug. 28, 2016, surrounded by her loving family.

Doris was born on Aug. 12, 1934, in Columbia, a daughter of Worth O'Dell and Wilma A. Whiting.

Doris was a hard-working woman her whole life. At one time, she worked at the Stratford Plywood Mill and the Northern Comfort Motel.
