



## Doris M. Carrier

July 1, 1927 - January 17, 2010

COLEBROOK, NH -- Mrs. Doris Mary (Lavertue) Carrier, 82, of Colebrook, NH, was taken by the Lord on Sunday afternoon, January 17, 2010, at her home after a two-year battle with cancer.

Doris was born on Brousseau Mountain in Averill, Vt., on July 1, 1927, the daughter of Claudia Brousseau Lavertue Noel and Laurent Lavertue. She graduated high school at St. Mary's Academy in Island Pond, Vt. Following graduation, she came to Colebrook for employment working as a secretary where she met her future husband, Armand Carrier, and they were married on July 1, 1947. In their marriage of 59 years, they raised six children. In 1952, Doris and Armand purchased Colebrook Plumbing & Heating, working hard at having a successful business until 1977. Doris enjoyed her family very much, and will always be remembered for her cheerful attitude, encouraging words, hard work and wonderful meals.

Doris was known for her tremendous generosity and spirit. She was a member of St. Brendan's Catholic Church, and as a Catholic Women's Club member, she was most proud to organize, through the memorial fund, a collection for a ramp to the entrance of the church helping the disabled and elderly to attend Mass. She always found ways to give to those in need of clothing, food or furniture.

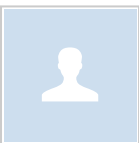
