



Dorothy E. Sweeney

April 18, 1923 - March 1, 2014

COLEBROOK, NH — Dorothy “Dot” E. Sweeney, 90, of Colebrook, and formerly of Pittsburg, passed away early on Saturday morning, March 1, 2014, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook after a long and brave battle with cancer, and with her daughter by her side.

She was born in Lyndonville, Vt., on April 18, 1923, a daughter to the late Jerry and Melissa (Libby) Lunderville.

In addition to raising her family, Dorothy worked at first for the North Stratford Plywood Mill, and later for six years she managed the Deer Mountain Campground in Pittsburg for the NH Division of Forestry. For 21 years she also worked at the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen. She loved to be outdoors to hunt and fish, and she loved to be doing different crafts, knitting, or crocheting. Dot also loved to tend to her flower garden.
