



Douglas J. Elliott Jr.

November 26, 1981 - September 23, 2017

COLEBROOK, NH — Douglas 'DJ' J. Elliott, Jr., 35, of Colebrook, died tragically as a result of injuries sustained in an automobile accident on Carlton Hill Road in Columbia on Saturday evening, Sept. 23, 2017.

He was born in Nashua, NH, on Nov. 26, 1981, the son of Douglas J. Elliott and Evelyn 'Sissy' Haynes. Doug attended Colebrook Academy and entered the U.S. Army in 2002.

DJ was a 'jack-of-all-trades,' and worked for many different people in the north country over time. He also enjoyed working for himself and was an accomplished welder. Most recently, he had employed as a cook at the Buck Rub Pub in Pittsburg which he enjoyed. He had a generous heart and was always willing to help someone in need. He loved his family dearly, and loved to spend time with his son. DJ loved to hunt and fish, be outside 4-wheeling or snowmobiling, and he loved to play cards, golf, and horseshoes. He was an avid fan of the New England Patriots, too.

DJ is survived by his son, Jared 'JD' Elliott, of Bloomfield, Vt.; his mother, Evelyn 'Sissy' Haynes-Kenney and her husband, James 'Popsie', of Magalloway Plantation, Me.; a sister, Marie Elliott of Colebrook; a brother, Michael Knapp and his wife Becca of Columbia; his grandmothers, LaVerna Cass of Columbia and Cheryl Lindsay of Newbury, Vt.; as well as numerous

cousins, uncles and aunts.

He is preceded in death by his father, Douglas J. Elliott, Sr.

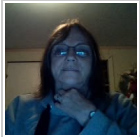

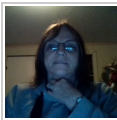

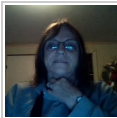
