



## Earl G. Dewey Sr.

April 4, 1930 - March 27, 2024

MORRISVILLE, VT – Earl G. Dewey, Sr., of Morrisville, Vt., and formerly of Colebrook, died unexpectedly at his home on Wednesday, March 27, 2024, eight days shy of his 94th birthday.

He enjoyed getting family and friends to debate about anything happening worldwide. Earl will be missed for his generosity, kindness, tending to everyone around him, and his sense of humor.
