COLUMBIA, NH -- Ms. Elizabeth "Betty" T. Delaney, 86, of Columbia, NH, passed away early Tuesday morning, December 13, 2011, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH, after a period of failing health.

She was born in Lockeport, Nova Scotia, on October 13, 1925, a daughter to the late Cornelius J. and Alma Mae (Brophy) Turner. At a very young age, Betty's family moved to the U.S.

Her working life was spent as a civilian stenographer for the U.S. military.
