CLARKSVILLE, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Mr. Elwin "Emmy" Jay Ladd, 80, of Clarksville, New Hampshire, passed away at his home Friday morning, May 9, 2008.

Emmy was born October 6, 1927, in West Stewartstown, NH, a son of the late Wesley and Ella (McPheters) Ladd.

Emmy lived in Clarksville for over 50 years and was actively involved in his hometown as the town clerk, school board member and as a selectman for many years.
