CANAAN, VERMONT – Mr. Emile “Frenchie” Caisse, Jr., 87, of Canaan, Vermont, formerly of Fall River, Massachusetts, passed away Tuesday, August 19, 2008, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital.

Mr. Caisse was born March 24, 1921, in Tiverton, RI, a son of the late Emile and Delvina (Despins) Caisse, Sr.

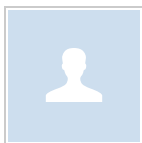
