



## Emile R. Therrien, Jr.

November 18, 1951 - June 24, 2011

COLEBROOK, NH-- Mr. Emile R. Therrien, Jr., 59, passed away on Friday evening, June 24, 2011, at Weeks Medical Center in Lancaster, NH, after a long period of ill health.

He was born in West Stewartstown, NH, on November 18, 1951, a son to the late Emile and Edna (Uran) Therrien.

Emile attended the first grade in Canaan, Vt., and was then tutored at home. His education continued later in life in Rutland and Waterbury, Vt., where he obtained his certification as a licensed nurses' aid. His working career was wide and varied, including work at the Ethan Allen furniture factory in Beecher Falls, at Tillotson Healthcare in Dixville, as kitchen help for many years at The Balsams and at restaurants in Colebrook and Beecher Falls, as a cook at Camp E-Toh-Anee, and helping local senior citizens. He also worked for Vershire and did home nursing care in the area.

He loved to knit and crochet, and Emile was well known for his love of all kinds of different crafts. He was a true "people person," who loved to be downtown on his scooter visiting with his many friends. Emile was a past member of the Colebrook Kiwanis Club, the Knights of Columbus, and the Jaycees.

Family members include his beloved wife, Amber (Normandeau) Therrien of Colebrook, NH; two sisters, Shirley Stevens and husband Charles O., of Stewartstown, NH, and Marion Dube and husband Dennis of Stewartstown; three brothers, Philip Therrien of Canaan, Vt., Victor Therrien and wife Helen of North Troy, Vt., and David Therrien and wife Penny of Beecher Falls, Vt.; as well as numerous nieces and nephews.
