Mrs. Emilie Potz, 92, of Ladd Road, Stewartstown, New Hampshire, passed away Wednesday morning, January 10, 2007, at her home surrounded by her loving family. Mrs. Potz was born September 4, 1914, in Germany, daughter of the late Ferdinand and Paulina (Bartz) Delau. Mrs. Potz was raised in Germany and lived through the difficult years of World War II. She married Rudolf Potz and moved to the United States in the early 1950's with her husband and two daughters. They initially lived in New Haven, CT, and later moved to Guilford, CT, where she raised her daughters and two sons and cared for her home. It wasn't until July of this past year that she moved to Stewartstown to be closer to her son and daughter-in-law. She loved to garden and enjoyed raising vegetables and tending to her flowers. She will be remembered as a woman of deep faith and will be dearly missed by all who knew and loved her.
