I lived with him and his wife at this point, and we were having a get together that night, so I refused to go to the hospital. Later, I was lounging with my knee elevated. He filled up my beer a couple times then said "F this. ", grabbed the Keg and placed it next to me. He says "Ya good bro?".... "Yeah, that works". Just a stupid day, but one I'll never forget.
