PITTSBURG – Ervena (Vena) Dorman, 88, of Pittsburg, passed away peacefully at her home on Wednesday, December 29, 2021, surrounded by her family, following several months of ill health.

She was born on August 6, 1933, a daughter to the late Carmi and Marion (Day) Hicks. She attended the Pittsburg School and was a life-long resident of Pittsburg. She married the love of her life, Thomas Dorman Jr., in June of 1951 and together they raised five children.

In her younger years, Vena worked as a housekeeper for many different camp owners. She worked at the Tillotson Rubber Factory in Dixville, and for a time, as a waitress. She later returned to housekeeping and was last employed by The Glen.

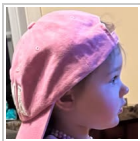
