



Eugene X. Shone

COLUMBIA, NH – Eugene X. Shone, 76, of Columbia and formerly of Woburn & Waltham, Mass., passed away at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH, on Monday morning, Aug. 11, 2014 with his family at his side. He had recently come to live in Colebrook to be with his beloved sister, Mary, during his final days.

Born in Woburn on June 29, 1938, he was the son of the late Francis X. and Irma (Studley) Shone. After his high school education, Eugene served with honor in the U.S. Marine Corps and later the Army Reserve.

He received two associate degrees at Middlesex Community College in Massachusetts in the healthcare field. His most recent jobs were at the Edith Nourse Rogers Memorial V.A. Hospital in Bedford, Mass., as a nurse's assistant; at Walden Nursing in Concord, Mass. as a CNA, and the Eliot Community Human Services in Lexington, Mass., as a residential counselor. Eugene was very much loved and cared for, and always brought a smile to everyone he met. He was a wonderful, caring and loving person who will be greatly missed.

He is survived by two sisters, Frances Poehler of Nashua, NH, and Mary Currier of Colebrook, NH; as well as 16 nieces and nephews.

He is preceded in death by his beloved wife of 22 years, Deborah (Clevenson) Shone, in July of 2014; three sisters, Alfreda Shone, Helen Foley, and Irma Carew; and a nephew, Richard Hassett, Jr.

There are no public calling hours. A memorial Mass will be held at 10 a.m. on Thursday, Aug. 21, at St. Albert's Catholic Church in West Stewartstown with The Rev. Craig Cheney as celebrant.
