



## Eugene "Gene" Bickford

September 5, 1944 - January 15, 2009

COLEBROOK, NH – Mr. Eugene “Gene” Bickford, 64, of Colebrook, passed away suddenly on Thursday evening, January 15, 2009, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH.
