ERROL – Fay Anita Hall, 87, formerly of Errol, died peacefully on Friday, December 1, 2023, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown, surrounded by her family.

Fay was born on July 4, 1936, in Eaton, Québec, Canada, the daughter of the late Guy and Rena (Harrison) Locke. In 1948, Guy and Rena moved to Pittsburg with their three daughters, Ida, Fay, and Agnes. Fay graduated as the valedictorian of the Pittsburg Class of 1954, and on August 12th of that year she married Burton Hawes Hall. Fay often reminisced about the Saturday night dances she and Burton attended at Tall Timbers, as a young couple, along with their many friends. They carried this love of music and dancing well into their later years.

Fay was a dedicated mother, raising two sons, Richard and Neil. There were always baked goodies in her kitchen, and an especial family favorite was her date pinwheel cookies. Fay carried on gardening, canning, and blueberry picking traditions throughout her life. She was a talented knitter, quilter, and seamstress, who gifted her work to loved ones.

Fay was a long time employee at the First Colebrook Bank and helped Burton run his businesses, B. Hall and Sons Logging and B. Hall Trucking. Following their retirement, Fay and Burton began traveling around the country by RV

with a caravan of friends. They loved to bring their grandchildren camping as well. In her later years, Fay treasured visits from her great-grandchildren.

Since 2016, Fay was a resident of the Coös County Nursing Hospital, where she was lovingly cared for by all staff.

Fay was predeceased by her loving husband, Burton, in 2006; and a sister, Agnes Griem in 1999. She is survived by her sister, Ida Johnson of Pittsburg, and sister-in-law, Elsie Hall of Errol; son and daughter-in-law Richard and Sandra Hall of Errol; son and daughter-in-law Neil and Carol Hall of Wilsons Mills; grandchildren Angela D'Antonio, Eric Hall, Melissa Hall, Justin Bonney, Casandra Wendell, Ezekiel Hall, and Elijah Hall; great-grandchildren Lila & Charles D'Antonio, Kendel & Avery Hall, Isabelle Ducret, Kaden, Kase, & Abigail Wendel, and Preston, Avery, & Broox Bonney; and many nieces and nephews.

Per Fay's request, there will be no calling hours or funeral services at this time. A graveside service will be held at the Indian Stream Cemetery in Pittsburg in the spring, of which notice will be given.
