WEST STEWARTSTOWN — Florence A. Mummey, 94, of West Stewartstown, passed away at the Coös County Nursing Hospital on Saturday, Jan. 12, 2019.

She was born on Feb. 1, 1924, in Bloomfield, Vt., a daughter to the late Harry and Stella (Ramsay) Savage. She attended grammar school in Bloomfield and was a 1941 graduate of Stratford High School.

Florence later attended Burdette Business College in Boston and worked in stocks and bonds for many years. She was the first woman stockbroker east of the Mississippi River. She lived in Boston for many years and retired to Georgia. Florence loved her local library wherever she was and was an avid reader.

She is survived by her two daughters, Sally Rafello of Seabrook, NH, and Lorraine (Tim) Preanor of Washington, DC; three sisters, Beverly Kettle of North Stratford, Barbara Savage of Bloomfield, and Faye Young of Groveton; one granddaughter, Nina Norris; as well as nieces and nephews.

She is preceded in death by her only brother, Paul Savage.
