



Florence "Flossie" Holden

August 3, 1930 - January 29, 2009

GOFFSTOWN, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Florence “Flossie” Holden, 78, of Goffstown, New Hampshire, formerly of Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away Thursday, January 29, 2009, at the Elliot Hospital in Manchester.

Flossie was born on August 3, 1930, in Groveton, NH, a daughter of Luger and Mildred (Bowen) Morin.

Flossie was raised in Colebrook and for a period of time lived at the Munn Farm in Colebrook. She often spoke of her difficult childhood, but the way in which she lived her life and her commitment to family served as a testament to her ability to overcome adversity. She worked at a young age, cleaning homes and cabins in Colebrook and Pittsburg. She also worked at Tillotson Rubber Company for a number of years. 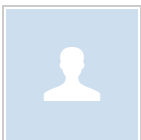
