March 20, 1933 - August 29, 2012

BLOOMFIELD, VT-- Mrs. Frances M. Caron, 79, of Bloomfield, Vt., died early Wednesday morning, Aug. 29, 2012, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital, with members of her family by her side.

She was born in North Stratford, NH, on March 20, 1933, a daughter to the late Frank and Geneva (Sanborn) Laythe.

For many years, Frances worked in the North Stratford plywood mill and also for the Brown Co. in Groveton. She and her family, for a time, lived also in Manchester, where Frances worked in manufacturing factories. Upon returning to the north country, she returned to working at the plywood mill and for 10 years at Tillotson Rubber Co. in Dixville. She will also be remembered for running a discount food store in Bloomfield with her husband for many years. Frances also was a caregiver for her siblings when she was younger, and also helped in caring for her grandchildren. Since 2005, Frances also provided home care for a neighboring senior.

She loved to fish, and she truly enjoyed flower gardens and the many hummingbirds that visited. Frances loved to be at work on a puzzle, and she loved to go riding the back roads, visiting yard sales, and attending the local fairs each year. She loved all her children and grandchildren more than anything. She didn't learn how to drive until she was 45, and always

considered that a great accomplishment.
