PITTSBURG – Frederick A. Martin, 73, of Pittsburg, passed away peacefully at his home late on Monday evening, May 25, 2015, surrounded by his loving family and friends.

He was born in Taunton, Mass., on Sept. 13, 1941, the only child of the late Alphonse A. and Rose (Arruda) Martin. Fred was raised and educated in Taunton.

His working career was as a supervisor in the salvage department at the Foxboro Company. Following retirement, he and his wife moved to Pittsburg, NH, where they could enjoy snowmobiling and ATVs and the rural life, and where they have resided for the past 27 years. Fred loved to hunt and target shoot, and for a period of time reloaded his own ammunition. He was a volunteer groomer for the Pittsburg Ridgerunners at one time, and was proud to have been part of the construction of the current clubhouse.

He is survived by his wife of more than 45 years, Beverly (White) Martin of Pittsburg; his son, Frederick A. Martin of Hatfield, Mass.; a daughter, Anne Martin-Cortez and husband Brian of Tewksbury, Mass.; and a grandson, Jacob Joseph Martin.
