COLUMBIA — Gary C. Grant, 65, of Columbia, passed away at the Lafayette Center in Franconia, NH, on Wednesday morning, July 31, 2019, after a brief struggle with brain cancer.

He was born on Dec. 21, 1953, in West Stewartstown, the son of the late George W. and Eleanor E. (Dewey) Grant.

At the age of 20, Gary began to work for the Tillotson Rubber Co. in Dixville, and he remained there for many years.

He got great joy from riding his motorcycle and driving his truck all over the north country of NH and northeast kingdom of Vermont, meeting and talking to people. A familiar face to many, he would often be found collecting aluminum cans all over the area which he then redeemed in Berlin. Gary was a past member of the Colebrook Jaycees.

He is survived by his sister, Donna E. Grant of Stewartstown, as well as aunts, uncles and cousins.

There are no public calling hours . A graveside interment service will be held in the Colebrook Village Cemetery on Tuesday, Aug. 6, 2019, at 11 a.m.

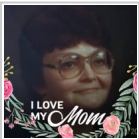

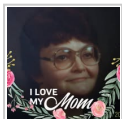
