COLEBROOK – Geraldine Carey Cross, 93, of Colebrook, died on Tuesday, May 5, 2020, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown after many years of declining health.

She was born on June 1, 1926 in Norton, Vt., the daughter of the late Marion (Carey) Elliott. She was raised by her mother and step-father, Ted Elliott, and attended schools in Canaan.

Geraldine married the love of her life in 1945, Roscoe Cross, and they settled down to raise their family and make their home in Canaan. She always enjoyed her home and spending time with her family and friends. Gerry frequently enjoyed playing Bingo and having lunch with her friends. For many years, she worked as a waitress at Frechette's Restaurant in Canaan. She will be remembered by all for her infectious laugh and wonderful sense of humor.
