COLUMBIA – Gerard ‘Jerry’ R. Poulin, 37, of Columbia, N.H., died unexpectedly on Monday, June 3, 2024.

He was born on Sept. 12, 1986, in Colebrook, a son to Steven and Kellie (Hartlen) Poulin. Jerry attended Colebrook schools and was a 2004 graduate of Colebrook Academy.
