July 14, 1963 - February 23, 2023

Gerard St. Onge, 59, of Goffstown, N.H., passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, Feb. 23, 2023, at the home of his father in Colebrook, N.H., after a day of doing what he loved, snowmobiling with his family in the north country.

He was born in Manchester, N.H., on July 14, 1963, a son to Donald D. and Gertrude I. (Dionne) St. Onge. He attended Goffstown High School.

At the time of his death, Gerry was employed by Skyline Roofing where he had worked for more than 30 years. He was a talented sheet metal fabricator and coppersmith.

He enjoyed snowmobiling, kayaking, fishing, bike riding, and spending time with his father in Colebrook.

Despite Gerry's challenging medical conditions, he maintained his strong work ethic, sense of humor and great kindness. He was always helping others.

Gerry leaves behind his father, Donald D. St. Onge of Colebrook; three brothers, Donald R. St. Onge of Henniker, N.H., Maurice R. (wife Lisa M.) St. Onge and Paul R. (wife Corinne) St. Onge of Goffstown; and his sister, Phyllis M.
