



Gilles Lamontagne

August 5, 1950 - February 25, 2009

COLUMBIA, NH -- Mr. Gilles Lamontagne, 58, of Columbia, passed away Wednesday morning, February 25, 2009, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH.

Gilles was born August 5, 1950, in St. George, Québec, Canada, a son of the late Roland Lamontagne and Rachel (Marcoux) Lamontagne.

Early in Gilles' life, the family moved to southern New Hampshire, and Gilles attended schools in Milford.

Gilles worked locally for the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen, as well as for Sheldon Gray in Colebrook, driving heavy equipment. He was an avid hunter and fisherman, and he especially loved the times that he was hunting in the woods with his son, Jesse. He also enjoyed tinkering on things mechanical with his son, Trevor.
