July 17, 1918 - August 11, 2011

WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH – Glendowin J. Bunnell, 93, of West Stewartstown, NH, passed away on Thursday afternoon, August 11, 2011, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown with her family at her side.

She was born at home in Pittsburg, NH, a daughter to the late Stewart and Hazel (Danforth) Haynes, and was educated in the local schools.

For most of her years, Glendowin was a homemaker for her family, but later worked as the housekeeping and laundry supervisor at the Coös County Nursing Hospital, the position from which she retired. She was a very private person, and an avid reader. The wisdom that she wished to leave with all who knew her was “to spend time with your family.”

Glendowin leaves behind her daughter, Colleen Carney and husband Howard of West Stewartstown; six grandchildren; twelve great-grandchildren; and two great-great-grandchildren.
