



Gordon L. Fogg

April 2, 1934 - July 6, 2013

NORTH STRATFORD — Gordon L. Fogg, 79, passed away peacefully, with his family holding his hand, early on Saturday morning, July 6, 2013, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH, lovingly cared for by the staff and his family, who were all by his side during a decline in health, and as he answered God's call.

Gordon was born in Milan, NH, on April 2, 1934, a son to the late Alton and Dorothy (Peabody) Fogg. The family moved to Colebrook when Gordon was a young child, and he later graduated with the Class of 1952 from Colebrook Academy. He served with honor in the U.S. Army in Korea, worked at many different jobs in the area, and retired from the Groveton Paper Board after 28 years of dedicated employment.

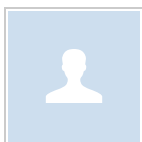

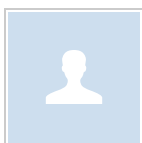
