NORTH STRATFORD, NH – Grace M. Hurley, 95, of North Stratford, NH, passed away peacefully late on Wednesday evening, December 8, 2010, at the Country Village Healthcare Center in Lancaster, after a long period of failing health.

Born on March 10, 1915, in Island Pond, Vt., Grace was a daughter of the late Walter and Elizabeth (Nolan) Weatherstone. She graduated from Island Pond High School in 1935 and was later married to Alton Hurley.

For her many years as a resident of North Stratford, Grace was a waitress and worked in food service at the Headstart program and for the Stratford schools. She loved to knit and crochet, and she had a renowned sense of humor. She was a former member of the Catholic Women's Club at Sacred Heart Church.

Grace is survived by four sons, William "Snooky" Hurley of North Stratford, Robert Hurley of Bloomfield, Vt., Philip Hurley and wife Robin of Columbia, NH, and Richard Hurley and wife, Rachel, of Columbia; eight grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren; as well as several nieces and nephews.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Alton; a daughter, Elizabeth Mulliken; three brothers, William, Calvin and Walter Weatherstone; and a

sister, Phila Russell.

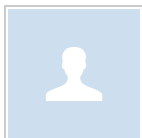

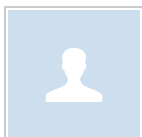
