



Guy V. Placey, Jr.

STEWARTSTOWN, NH -- Mr. Guy V. Placey, Jr., 79, of Stewartstown, NH, passed away late on Tuesday, October 7, 2008, at Weeks Medical Center in Lancaster, NH, after a period of declining health.

Mr. Placey was born on April 13, 1929, in Stewartstown, a son of the late Guy V. Placey, Sr., and Evelyn (Towle) Placey.
