June 14, 1942 - October 27, 2021

PITTSBURG – Hallie R. Perron, 79, of Pittsburg, died unexpectedly at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook on Wednesday, Oct. 27, 2021. Her sons were at her side.

She was born on June 14, 1942, in Pittsburg, a daughter to the late Ralph and Ruth (Osgood) Huggins.

Throughout the years, Hallie worked at Ethan Allen and as a waitress at Moriah's, and then Dube's. She is perhaps best known as Pittsburg's Avon lady, which she sold for over 20 years, as was always evident at Christmastime with the stocking stuffers she gave to her family. She loved Christmas and with a family as large as hers, it was a big gathering with a tree that was hard to see behind the mountain of gifts.

Hallie enjoyed spending time with her family. She was very close to her sisters and spent many shopping trips and vacations with them. She had a lifetime love for George Jones, which she shared with her son, Scottie. They saw him 9 times in concert, including the farewell tour in which they travelled to Tennessee. She will be greatly missed by her family and close friends.

Hallie is survived by her seven sons: Jimmy, Johnny (Mary), Ronnie (Kim), Donnie (Nancy), Scottie, Timmy, Toby (Stephanie); her adopted son, Jim

Therrien; a sister, Marjorie (Bernard) Straw of Pittsburg; 10 grandchildren, 4 great-grandchildren. and many nieces and nephews.

She is preceded in death by her children, Edward and Connie; a sister, Eva Lemay; a brother, Billy Osgood; her husband, Brandon Perron; and her lifelong friend, Joanne Foote, who was always by Hallie's side for an adventure.
