COLEBROOK, NH—Harriet “Harve” E. Wetherby, 64, of Colebrook, NH, passed away on Wednesday morning, July 25, 2012, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook after a period of declining health.

She was born in Williamstown, Mass., on December 27, 1947, the only child of Frank and Irene (Robare) Weeks. Harriet attended school in Massachusetts and graduated from Drury High School in North Adams in 1964 at the age of 17.
