



Hartley L. Sweatt

May 4, 1921 - December 16, 2007

MILLSFIELD, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Mr. Hartley L. Sweatt, 86, of Millsfield, New Hampshire, passed away Sunday evening, December 16, 2007, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital.

Mr. Sweatt was born May 4, 1921, in Errol, NH, son of the late Loren and Edith (Grover) Sweatt.

Mr. Sweatt was a graduate of Colebrook Academy. Following graduation, he served honorably in the United States Army during World War II. He worked for G.O. Thurston in Errol for 23 years and later for the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation, where he retired after 16 years of employment. He also worked for the Errol Consolidated School as a janitor while also enjoying his hobby as a farmer at the Clear Stream Farm in Millsfield. His interest in agriculture and farming was recognized when he received the 4-H Lifetime Achievement Award. His other passions included hunting, gardening, playing cribbage and spending time with his family.

Mr. Sweatt is survived by his son, Lewis “Chewy” Sweatt and wife, Paula, of Millsfield; his daughter, Reta Hickey of Rochester, NH; his daughter-in-law, Jane Abbott Sweatt of New London, NH; six grandchildren, Amelia Sweatt, David Sweatt, Scott Sweatt, Peter Sweatt, Mark Hickey and Laurie Bernier; three great-grandchildren; and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.

Mr. Sweatt is preceded in death by his loving wife of 52 years, Etta (Raymond) Sweatt; his son, Lorence Sweatt; a brother, Lloyd Sweatt; and five sisters, Mabel, Lydia, Irene lola and Avilla.
