



Heidi L. Fysh

June 7, 1975 - September 15, 2015

PITTSBURG – Heidi L. Fysh, 40, of Pittsburg and formerly of Del Valle, Tex., died suddenly on Tuesday, Sept. 15, 2015, in Colebrook, NH, after three years of courageously struggling with cancer.

She was born in Berlin, NH, the only daughter of Brenton and Lucinda (Minnon) Fysh. She was raised in the Plymouth area, attended Campton Elementary School and was a 1993 graduate of Plymouth Regional High School. She then attended Concord Technical Institute, Franklin Pierce College, and received a master's degree in science in 2001 from Springfield College.

Her professional career began in Texas working for the state as an inspector and investigator in the health & human services department. She later established and ran her own plant nursery business, the "Canna Queen," which blossomed into a thriving enterprise and received a "Best of Austin, Texas" award in 2010. Her business was a great success, achieved in a very short period of time, until she sold it for health reasons. Plants were Heidi's passion, along with raising her children.

She leaves behind two children, Jacob Fysh of Brookline, NH, and Jada Fysh of Pittsburg; her parents, Brenton and Lucinda Fysh of Pittsburg; twin brothers, Matthew Fysh of Campton, NH, and Nathan Fysh and wife Christine

of Belmont, NH; her grandmother, Marion Fysh, of Newport Richey, Fla.; two aunts, Kendra Dussault of Newport Richey, and Brenda Gray of Westbrook, Me.; three uncles, Charles Fysh of Berlin, NH, John Minnon of Bow, NH, and Peter Minnon of Colorado; as well as five nieces and nephews.

There are no public calling hours. A memorial service and celebration of Heidi's life will be held at the Farnham Memorial United Methodist Church in Pittsburg, NH, on Saturday, Oct. 3, at 1 p.m., with The Rev. Paula Fletcher officiating.

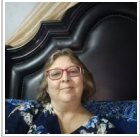
