



## Henry "Pat" Joseph Rodrique

February 25, 1917 - February 17, 2007

Mr. Henry "Pat" Joseph Rodrique, 89, just eight days shy of his 90th birthday, passed away late Saturday evening, February 17, 2007, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital.
