



Holman M. Brooks

August 31, 1918 - March 1, 2004

Mr. Holman M. Brooks, 85, of Diamond Pond Road, Colebrook, NH, passed away Monday morning, March 1, 2004, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital.

Mr. Brooks was born August 31, 1918, at home on North Hill in Stewartstown, NH, son of the late Harold and Marion (McConnell) Brooks.

Mr. Brooks served in the United States Army during World War II, receiving an honorable discharge and leaving the service in September, 1945. For many years, Mr. Brooks owned and operated a farm, during which he also worked for Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen. When his children moved from home, he then sold the farm and went to work for Tillotson Rubber Company in the machine shop until his retirement at the age of 70. He loved being outdoors and gardening. He also enjoyed animals. He was a member of the National Rifle Association and the George L. O'Neil American Legion & Auxiliary, Post #62, Colebrook. He also served as Selectman for the Town of Clarksville.

Mr. Brooks is survived by his four children: Marcia Pond and husband, George, of Plymouth, NH, Barbara Hann and husband, Bradley, of Colebrook, NH, Stephen Brooks and wife, Kristin, of Columbia, NH, and Thomas Brooks and wife, Micheline, of Colebrook, NH; three brothers: Howard Brooks of

Columbia, NH, Lester Brooks of Clarksville, NH, and Roy Brooks of Stewartstown, NH; two sisters: Ramona Brooks of Colebrook, NH, and Rita Brigham of Stewartstown, NH; nine grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.
