



## Ida L. Johnson

August 24, 1934 - January 1, 2025

W. STEWARTSTOWN – Ida L. Johnson, 90, died early on Wednesday, Jan. 1, 2025, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in W. Stewartstown.

She was born in Eaton, Québec, on Aug. 24, 1934, a daughter to the late Guy and Rena (Harrison) Locke. Ida moved to Pittsburg as a young teenager and attended Pittsburg High School, graduating in 1954. She then entered nursing school in Sherbrooke, graduating in 1957. Ida married Embert Johnson in 1958.

She worked as a registered nurse for more than 30 years, the whole time at the Coos County Nursing Hospital. When CCNH was the only hospital in the region, she worked as a nurse in the operating room. She retired in 1989.

In her younger days, Ida loved to snowmobile in the winter, always taking the February school vacation week off with her children to do just that. She also enjoyed traveling, taking many trips, especially an unforgettable one to Alaska with friends in the early 90s. Ida loved to play cards and BINGO, making it to the Legion to play each Tuesday night. While still living at home in Pittsburg, she also enjoyed making a nightly visit to her dear friend and neighbor, Katherine Covill.

Ida is survived by her two daughters, Heidi (Robert) McComiskey of Canaan,

and Inger (Bruce) Cyr of Gorham, Me.; three grandchildren and one great-grandchild. She is predeceased by her husband, Embert, in 2003, and two sisters, Faye Hall and Agnes Greim.

There are no public calling hours. A graveside interment service will be held at the Pittsburg Hollow Cemetery on Hill Road on Saturday, June 14, 2025, at 11 a.m.
