December 3, 1942 - March 11, 2024

COLEBROOK – Inez Haney, 81, of Colebrook, passed away on Monday, March 11, 2024, at the Country Village Healthcare Center in Lancaster after a long period of declining health.

She was born on Dec. 3, 1942, in West Stewartstown, a daughter of the late John and Madeline (Bean) Haney.

For a time in her younger days, Inez worked at the Crotched Mountain Rehabilitation Center in Greenfield, N.H. Later, she did home respite care for several people in her hometown of Colebrook, as well. A familiar person around the town, Inez enjoyed crocheting, reading, walking, and visiting residents at the nursing home in W. Stewartstown. She also enjoyed being on her computer.

There will be a memorial celebration of Inez's life on Saturday, April 6, 2024, at 11 a.m. at the Faith Chapel Assembly of God Church in Columbia, with a luncheon to follow. Inez will be privately interred with her parents in the Reed Cemetery on Forbes Hill Road in East Colebrook later in the spring.

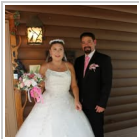

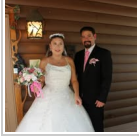
