COLEBROOK – Isabelle Marie Brunault, 98, of Colebrook, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, Jan. 6, 2021, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown.

She was born on Oct. 16, 1922, in Coaticook, Quebec, a daughter to the late Treffle and Florence (Bourassa) Hebert.

Isabelle obtained her nursing degree in Nashua, and worked as a registered nurse for a short period of time. Later, with her husband, they owned and operated Paul's Shoe Store and the Northern Comfort Motel, retiring in 1985. For many years, Isabelle enjoyed wintering in Florida.
