



Ivona M. Hartshorn

ATLANTA, GA – Ivona M. Hartshorn, 88, passed away on Sunday, July 26, 2020, at the Emory St. Joseph's Hospital in Atlanta, Ga., after a long period of failing health.

She was born in Pittsburg on May 21, 1932, a daughter to the late Ivo and Vena (Washburn) McKeage. She attended the local schools and was a 1950 graduate of Pittsburg High School.

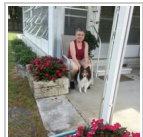
