PITTSBURG, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Ivy P. Schmidt, 87, of Jenkintown, Pennsylvania, passed away on Friday morning June 20, 2008 after a short period of failing health. She was staying at a private residence in Pittsburg NH.

Ivy was born July 18, 1920, in Earl Township, Berks Co., PA., one of twelve children of the late George Renninger and Edith (Besfer) Renninger.

She grew up in Gilbertsville, PA. and after attending school moved to Wilmington, DE. She married Harry Schmidt in Wilmington in 1939 and lived there before moving to Philadelphia, PA in 1951. In 1963 the family moved to Jenkintown PA.

Ivy was self taught in many of the things she did over the years. She enjoyed remodeling her home, upholstering, caning, and refinishing furniture. Sharon Schmidt of Willow Grove, PA. In addition there are four grandchildren, Leeanne, Eric, Jessica and Sierra, and 3 great-grandchildren Chandler, Lola, and Kodi. She has one surviving sister, Ella West and husband Joe of Newark, DE, as well as numerous nieces and nephews. Ivy also spent many happy times with her good friend Wanda McKeage and her husband for which the family is grateful.

Ivy Schmidt was preceded in death by her husband Harry in 1988 and her four brothers; Earl, Frances, Purnell and Melvin as well as four sisters, Verona, Maude, Naomi and Edith. Two siblings died in childhood.
