



Jane F. Stevens

February 12, 1920 - August 31, 2021

CANAAN – Jane F. Stevens, 101, of Canaan, passed away peacefully on Tuesday morning, Aug. 31, 2021, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown.

She was born on Feb. 12, 1920, in Canaan, a daughter to the late Frank and Lula (Wright) Fuller. In 1935, the family moved to Whitefield, and Jane was a 1937 graduate of Whitefield High School. In 1943, she moved to New Haven, Conn., and was married to Clayton L. Stevens in 1944.

For many years, Jane worked as a secretary for the Connecticut Dept. of Transportation in Woodbridge, Conn., retiring in 1983. She returned to Canaan with her husband in 1984.

She was a long-time member of the Canaan Women's Bowling League, and she also enjoyed playing cards (especially Pitch) and most sports. At the time of her death, Jane was, as its eldest citizen, the holder of the Boston Post Cane for the Town of Canaan.

She is survived by several nieces and nephews. Jane is predeceased by her husband, Clayton, in 2015, as well as by six brothers and four sisters.

There are no public calling hours. A graveside interment service for both Mr.

and Mrs. Stevens, with military honors for Mr. Stevens, will be held on Friday, Sept. 10, 2021, at 11 a.m. in the Alice Hunt Cemetery on Rt. 114 in Canaan.
