COLEBROOK – Janice A. Jackson, 90, of Colebrook, passed away at her home early on Monday morning, Sept. 19, 2022, surrounded by her family.

She was born in Clarksville on Feb. 25, 1932, a daughter to the late Perley E. and Miriam (Edwards) Fearon. She was a 1949 graduate of Canaan Memorial High School, and graduated in 1953 from the Maine Medical School of Nursing as a RN. She continued her education at various colleges throughout New England and received a Bachelor degree in Gerontology in 1981 from Emmanuel College in Boston.

During her 44-year nursing career, Janice worked in the fields of psychiatry in Hartford, CT and NY City, obstetrics in Ithaca, NY, emergency medicine and public health in Needham, MA. In 1988, she and her husband returned to Colebrook where she began a new career in industrial nursing at Bose Corporation.

She had a special passion for art including her own oil landscape paintings which were exhibited and sold through the area. She loved cross country skiing, swimming and volunteering in both the community and the church.

Janice is survived by her loving husband of 63 years, Carroll "Tom" Jackson, Jr. of Colebrook; two daughters, Shellie Bresnahan (Mike) of Canaan, VT, and Linda Hutchinson (David) of Honeoye Falls, NY; her son, Scott Jackson (Diane) of Gig Harbor, WA.; a brother, Joel Fearon (Ruth) of Vergennes, VT; a sister-in-law, Mary Fearon of St Johnsbury, VT; three granddaughters; and numerous nieces and nephews.

She is predeceased by an older brother, James Fearon.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, May 13, 2023, at 11 a.m. at the Monadnock Congregational Church in Colebrook. A graveside committal will immediately follow at the Perry Cemetery on West Road in Clarksville.

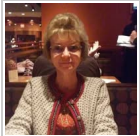
