CANAAN – Jason A. Atwood, 32, of Beecher Falls, died unexpectedly in Canaan on Saturday, Aug. 13, 2022.

He was born in Lebanon, N.H., on July 18, 1990, a son to John and Christine (Wheeler) Atwood.

Jason was a jack-of-all-trades. He had a strong work ethic, always willing to lend a hand, went above and beyond and always did it with a smile.

In his free time Jason loved hunting fishing, four-wheeling and snowmobiling. Ice fishing was by far his favorite hobby, especially with his best friend Travis, cousin Carl, and his father. Jason and his dad loved spending time together trap shooting. In 2020, Jason shot a trophy buck with his father's gun, of which he was very proud.

amazing cook, as well, notably for his “cheesy shells,” and considered himself a “grill master.” He also loved nothing more than his mother’s homemade donuts. He enjoyed making his own maple syrup each spring and being part of the Dearth Mountain Sugar House clan on Back Pond Road in Stewartstown.

Jason would never pass up a chance for a ride or a snuggle with his beloved black lab, Gunner.

Surviving family includes his wife of 9 years, Cassandra (Hunt) Atwood of Beecher Falls; his mother, Christine Atwood of W. Stewartstown; his sister, Jamie Brousseau and her husband Adam of Ft. Drum, N.Y.; and his beloved niece and nephew, Adalynn and Jackson.

He is predeceased by his dad, John Atwood, in 2020.
