



Jason Howe

December 1, 1927 - January 6, 2015

WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH — Mr. Jason Howe, 87, of West Stewartstown, died tragically on Tuesday, Jan. 6, 2015, due to injuries received in an automobile accident on Route 3 in Colebrook.

He was born in West Stewartstown on Dec. 1, 1927, the son of the late Tillie and Bessie (Roby) Howe. Jason was a 1945 graduate of Pittsburg High School.

Soon after high school, Jason moved to Plymouth, NH, where he worked for 30 years as a cook at Plymouth State College. He retired in 1975 and returned to his native north country. Jason was also an amateur musician, and he played in a band for many years entertaining at local dances and for community groups.

He leaves behind his nephew, Irving “Tink” Hicks and wife Rose of Clarksville, and a niece, Dencie Hicks of Colebrook; as well as several great-nieces and nephews.

At Jason’s request, there are no public calling hours or services scheduled. He will be laid to rest at a later date in the Pittsburg Hollow Cemetery with his parents.
