STRATFORD – Jason J. Sperry, Sr., 43, of North Stratford, passed away unexpectedly at his home on Saturday, Oct. 18, 2025.

He was born in Lancaster, N.H., on Feb. 14, 1982. Jason attended schools in Colebrook and Rhode Island. He had a lifelong love of music. The summer before entering 4th grade in Rhode Island, Jason was coached by Colebrook's music teacher, Mr. Killam, on the saxophone which later earned him a silver medal in a sax competition in Rhode Island. He was a member of the school band and a solo singer.

Hiking and camping with his son was his ultimate joy. (Jay Jr, was also his sax competition!) The two would attend many concerts and festivals. Jason had a big heart and would help anyone in need. His love for animals throughout his life was evident most recently with the rescue of his Siberian cat "Benz." The love of his life was "Bella," a beautiful Rottweiler who predeceased him on Christmas Eve of 2024. Other enjoyments for Jason were card playing, darts, pool with friends, and he was especially proud of his "suped up" Toyota and teaching his grandmother how to drive it!

Jason worked many years as a local satellite TV tech before a career in the building industry, which was curbed by a workplace accident and then multiple surgeries.

He is survived by his son, Jason Sperry, Jr., of North Conway; his mother, Deborah Sperry, and his grandmother, Rose Eastman of Beecher Falls, Vt.; his uncle, Jim (Lynda) Sperry of Maine, and his cousins, Jimmy in Georgia and Ryan in Colorado.

Jason is predeceased by his grandfather, Jim Sperry, Sr.

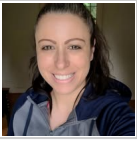
