



Jean-Justin Lindor

May 22, 1946 - September 25, 2014

CANAAN, VT — Mr. Jean-Justin Lindor, 68, of Canaan, passed away on Thursday evening, Sept. 25, 2014, at the Weeks Memorial Hospital in Lancaster, NH.

He was born in Port-au-Prince, Haiti, on May 22, 1946, a son to the late Augustin and Auralie (Alexis) Lindor. He was educated in Haiti, obtaining a degree as a French teacher, and he also served for a time in the Haitian military prior to emigrating to the U.S.

After arriving in the U.S., the Lindor family first settled in Brooklyn, NY, and later in Waterbury, Conn. Mr. Lindor moved with his family to northern Vermont in 2011, and they pursued a career as restaurateurs. Jean-Justin was an outgoing and friendly man who loved his family, especially time spent with his grandchildren. He was also a member of the Freemasons in Connecticut.

Mr. Lindor is survived by his only son, Jean Lindor and wife Iris of Canaan; his five grandchildren, Monique, Justin, Joshua, Matthew and Morgan Lindor; as well as two brothers and two sisters in Brooklyn, NY. He is preceded in death by his wife of 40 years, Marie-Jose (Mystal) Lindor in 2013.

Calling hours will be on Friday, Oct. 10, 2014, from 6 – 8 p.m. at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held

the following morning, Saturday, Oct. 11, at 10 a.m. at St. Albert's Catholic Church in West Stewartstown with The Rev. Craig Cheney as celebrant. Burial will immediately follow at the Alice Hunt Cemetery in Canaan.
