W. STEWARTSTOWN— Jeannine Rouleau Boire, 89, of Colebrook, passed away on Friday evening, Jan. 27, 2017, at the Coos County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown where she had been a resident for the past 3 years. She had been a resident of Colebrook for 54 years.
